All Atonement youth in grades 4 through 12 are invited to "Walk with the World," by participating in the annual CROP Walk on October 14. Last year CROP Hunger Walks raised more than \$15 million to support the hunger-fighting

work of local food banks around the block and of Church World Service around the world.

Free will donation. Please sign up on the bulletin board by the back parking lot.



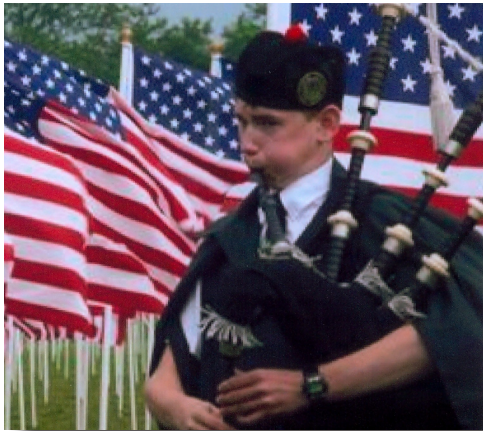
